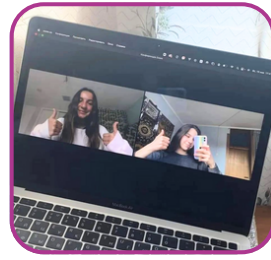


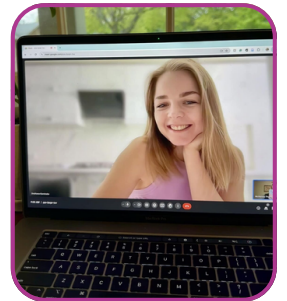

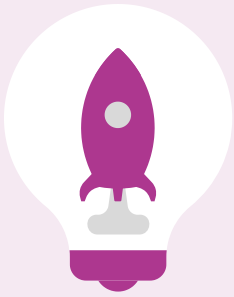

ENGIN is a pioneering nonprofit organization that pairs English-speaking volunteers with English learners abroad for weekly video chat conversations. 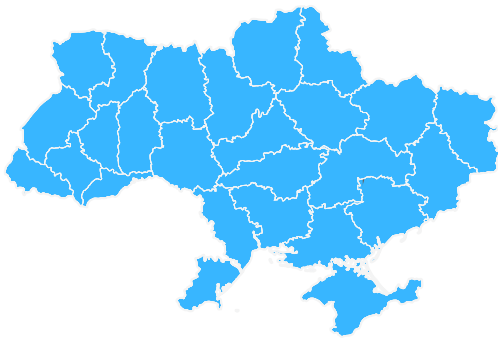

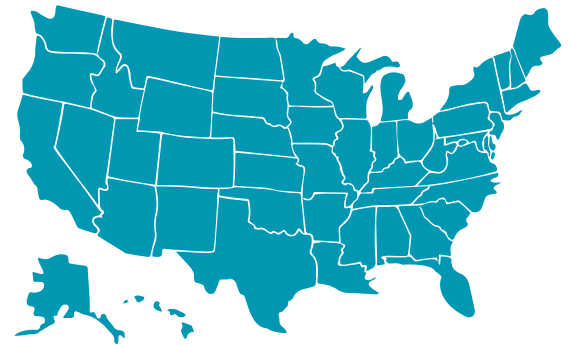

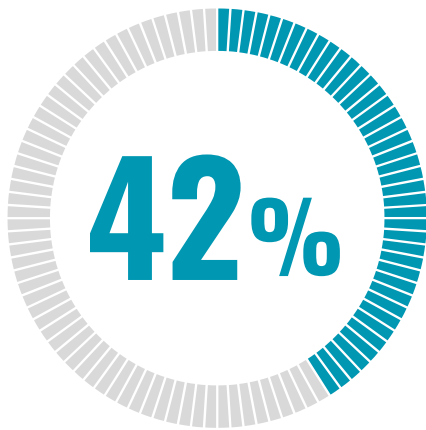
