ENGin is creating a generation of English-proficient leaders ready to shape Ukraine's future one conversation at a time.

THE PROGRAM

ENGin — an engine propelling Ukraine's progress — is a program that connects Ukrainian learners with fluent English speakers for weekly one-on-one conversations.

We believe that **English proficiency** is crucial for rebuilding Ukraine,



empowering individuals, and fostering global connections. Open to all Ukrainians, regardless of their location, ENGin provides a lifeline to those displaced by the war.

Through personalized instruction and cultural exchange, **ENGin builds confidence**, **broadens perspectives, and unlocks new opportunities.** Participants typically commit to 3-12 months of weekly conversations, experiencing sustained language growth.



While English is taught in Ukrainian schools, students' ability to speak the language is often limited. ENGin focuses on **practical conversation skills** and cultural competence, preparing learners to thrive in a globalized world.


